Substrate Preparation

Preparation is similar to normal good decorative practice.

- Protect non target surfaces with dust sheets.
- Prepare surfaces by removing non washable and loose material e.g. flaking paint, grease, dirt, mould or wallpaper
- Make good any surface defects and run down to a smooth surface

Mixing

Dilute 1 part PermaPROTECT Mould Wash Concentrate with 19 parts Water (whole container makes 5 litres of ready to use product)

Application
