Active

The innovative formulation technology in Permagard Wood Worm Killler contains the synthetic pyrethroid insecticide Permethrin. The insecticide is effective against all life stages of wood boring insects whilst the surfactant system used in the formulation promotes rapid absorption and deep penetration into timber.

Description

Permagard Wood Worm Killler is a micro-emulsion system using advanced surfactant chemistry to achieve the desired effect in a non solvent and VOC free based system. Its active ingredients are designed to give the maximum spectrum of biological activity against a wide range of wood boring insects (specifically woodworm) including their larvae. The surfactant system promotes rapid absorption into the timber giving high levels of penetration. It has virtually no odour and can be applied either by brush or low pressure spray to give long lasting protection.

This specifically formulated micro-emulsion exhibits very low surface tension giving very even wetting and spreading of the active ingredients. The product can be applied to damp timber Permagard Wood Worm Killler is supplied as a ready to use product with a 0.2% Permethrin level for use. It has a HSE statutory 1-hour re-entry time (or until surfaces are dry).

Permagard Wood Worm Killler is cleared under the Governments Pesticide Safety Precaution scheme and under the Control of Pesticide Regulations 1986.

Preparation

Timber to be treated should be reasonably dry before treatment (although the surfactant system will allow penetration into wet timbers). Any paint, varnish or other surface coatings should be removed prior to application.

Application

Permagard Wood Worm Killer can be applied by brush, spray or dipping (minimum of 3 minutes) at the rate of 1 litre of product per 3 to 4 square metres of timber surface.

Coverage

The product should be applied at a rate of 1 litre of product per 3 to 4 square metres of timber surface.
